



### Bachelor of Arts/Bachelor of Laws (BA/LLB) 2008 Course code 0080 (252 credit points)

The law component requires that students complete 156 points of study, consisting of 12 compulsory units and a further 84 points of elective units.

The arts component requires that students complete 96 points of arts units consisting of three first-year sequences, a major sequence in an arts discipline, a minor sequence in another arts discipline and two additional arts elective units. Students may graduate with the Bachelor of Arts, or undertake honours in arts at the end of three years of study, provided they have met the requirements of the Bachelor of Arts program and completed a minimum of 144 points of total study.

The units listed below are known as the 'quasi-compulsory' units. Students do not need to complete these units to obtain their LLB so technically, they are elective units. However, students who wish to practice law in Victoria must complete these units as part of their law electives(\*):
