



Bachelor of Commerce/Bachelor of Laws (BCom/LLB) 2008 Course code 0546 (252 credit points)

The law component requires students to take 156 points of study, consisting of 12 compulsory units and a further 84 points of Law elective units.

To complete the commerce component, students must complete 96 points of study, including:

1. Five compulsory common core units (30 credit points):

AFC1021 Accounting principles, ECC1000 Principles of microeconomics, ETC1000 Business and economic statistics, MGC1010 Managing people and organisations, MKC1200 Principles of marketing

2. At least two units from the following list:

AFC1100/AFC2100 Introduction to finance OR AFC1030 Introductory financial accounting, ECC1100 Principles of macroeconomics, ETC1010 Data modelling and computing, MGC1020 Organisations: contexts and strategies

No more than 48 points (eight units) may be taken at first-year level. Students must also complete a major sequence (48 points) in a discipline offered by the faculty. Please refer to the Faculty of Business and Economics section of the University Handbook 2005 for major requirements.

NB: Students cannot graduate from the Bachelor of Commerce until they have satisfied the above requirements *and* completed units Corporations Law (LAW4171) and Equity (LAW4169)

The units listed below are known as the 'quasi-compulsory' units. Students do not need to complete these units to obtain their LLB so technically, they are elective units. However, students who wish to practice law in Victoria must complete these units as part of their law electives(*):

LAW5125 Lawyers, ethics and society

LAW4170 Trusts

LAW5104 Civil procedure
